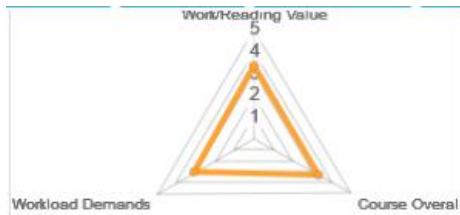
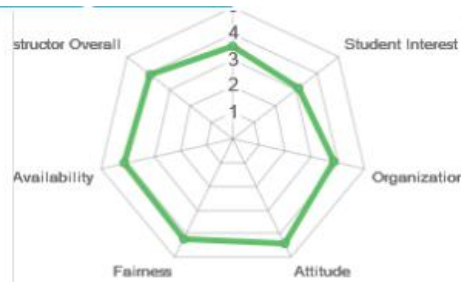


# Leadership, Communication, and Teams Statistics and Student Comments
